## Residential Central A/C and ASHP Rebate Program

### Overview:

In order to generate maximum electric energy savings for the customer, the Central A/C and ASHP Rebate program focuses on installation practices. We seek to validate four components for the installation: proper sizing, airflow, refrigerant charge and duct sealing.

### Eligibility:

Customer applying for the rebate must reside in SWCE's service territory and receive residential electric service from the cooperative.

### \*\*Program Requirements:

In order to receive rebates customers must use a contractor who is currently registered through HVACReduction.net to install qualifying equipment. These contractors have agreed to the terms of the program and passed a test demonstrating their knowledge of quality installation practices.
