Rebate available

Residential cooperative members are eligible for a \$30 rebate for the LED fixture only (not the bulb) installed in the cooperative's service territory.

- Must be ENERGY STAR or DLC rated
- 50-100 watt LED replacements for High Pressure Sodium, Metal Halide, Mercury Vapor, or in new installations.
