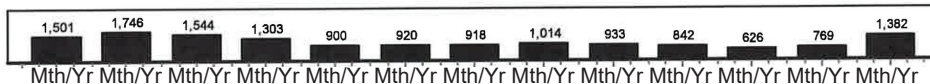

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1. Your SWCE account number; 2. Bill payments are due by the 12th; 3. The date the bill was prepared; 4. The mailing address of the person(s) responsible for the bill; 5. The amount due on the bill; 6. The balance due if paid after the 12th; 7. The meter number for your service location; 8. The starting date for your monthly bill's meter reading; 9. The ending date for your monthly bill's meter reading; 10. The number of kilowatt hours (KWH) used during your billing period; 11. Part of the cost to deliver electricity to your service address. The remainder is part of your KWH rate; 12. The rate for up to the first 1,000 KWH of electric usage; 13. The rate for electric usage exceeding 1,000 KWH; 14. The amount above your rate to cover the cost of purchasing power; 15. The credit you receive for joining a SWCE load control program; 16. The amount of interest earned on the deposit held by SWCE; 17. The address receiving electric service from SWCE; 18. A graphical summary of your monthly KWH usage.
